The Office of Head Start & Public Schools Collaboration Demonstration Project was held from June 2019–June 2020 and included 13 teams from across the country. Teams included leaders, early childhood educators, and parents from Head Start programs and their receiving elementary schools/districts. Each team established a common goal to improve the transition to kindergarten for children and families. Over the course of the year that followed, they held regular check-ins and worked toward their goal with support from the Office of Head Start.
