

Comparing Formal and Informal Communication

Basis of Comparison	Formal Communication	Informal Communication
Definition	Exchange of information through pre-defined channels	Exchange of information in any or all directions
Also Called	Official communication	Grapevine communication
Advantage	Timely and systematic	Allows free discussion at many different levels of an organization
Disadvantage	Can be distorted by flow through many chains of command	Can be distorted by rumors
Confidentiality	Confidentiality can be maintained	Confidentiality is difficult to maintain
Reliability	Highly reliable	Comparatively less reliable
Speed	Slow	Fast
Evidence	Leaves a paper or electronic trail, maintaining documentary evidence	Usually leaves no written trail
