


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Promoting Parent-Child Interaction

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**Identify** the strengths of the parent and **limit** the focus on weaknesses





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




Everyday routines in the


home include both housekeeping and caregiving routines with children.

Every home has their own unique routines.





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
Strategies to Support Parents as Facilitators of Learning



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














### Supporting Teachable Moments: Everyday Material

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The parent's role as facilitator of their child's learning is present in every setting where they are together.





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



