Anticipate.

Think through activities, routines, and situations.

Plan.

Develop a plan to support appropriate behaviors by determining which behaviors you want children to use and which behaviors you do not want to see.

Prepare children.

- State expected behaviors in advance.
- Post expectations.
- Provide demonstrations.
- Use role play.
- · Lead discussions.



Recognize appropriate behavior.

Give recognition and feedback:

- Catch children following the expected behaviors.
- Make a statement about their effort.
- Encourage them to keep it up!
