

TEACHER SARA BUILDS ON TODDLERS' PERSONAL INTERESTS

In this video, infant and toddler teacher, Sara, uses her curriculum responsively based on the children's interests. This curriculum provides a learning experience in which toddlers explore objects and teachers offer materials that children can insert and take out. It also encourages teachers to narrate children's actions based on the ways they use the materials—focusing on vocabulary words such as "in" and "out."
