



CONVERSATIONS FROM CHILDREN'S BOOKS

Identify novel words that children may not understand from children's books you read aloud in the classroom. For each novel word, write a child-friendly definition that explains the meaning of the word. Remember that these definitions need to be simple and should not include any unfamiliar words for the child.

Novel word	Child-friendly definition
Reef	A reef is under the water, it can be very sharp and very big. It is like a big rock with holes in it where different animals, like fish, can live.
Cookbook	A cookbook is a book you read. The words tell you how to make the food. In this story, the little boy is using the cookbook to read how to make bread.
