Planning assessment	Teachers have a data collection plan that is adhered to by all teaching staff.			
Gathering information	Teachers use multiple data collection methods. Data are collected during daily classroom activities and			

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Organizing information	Teachers have a system to organize data for each child.	
Understanding and interpreting information	Teaching teams meet regularly to review and interpret child assessment information. They look for patterns to determine how children are progressing.	
Adjusting teaching based on data	Teaching teams decide whether to make adjustments in teaching, based on children's progress.	
Sharing with families	Teaching teams partner with families in gathering and sharing information on children's learning. They seek family input in interpreting information and making decisions about teaching.
