

ACTIVITY PLAN FOR ASSESSMENT

Activity overview: In this activity, you will practice planning how to gather assessment information while teaching.

Read the example below; Jason and his two teaching assistants have planned how they will gather assessment information during a small group activity in the outdoor play area. Then use the following page to develop your own plan for gathering assessment information.

Example:

Jason and his two teaching assistants have set up a number of gross motor games that the children may use during outdoor play time. There are balls to bounce and throw into a low basketball hoop. There are beanbags to toss into a basket. There is also an area with balls of various sizes to catch and throw. In addition to introducing the activities to the class, the teaching team plans to provide guided practice to small groups of children. Later in the week, these games will be available as choices during outdoor play time.

The chart below shows how Jason and his teaching team have planned to gather assessment information during the small group guided practice activity. A blank version of this chart is included at the end of this document for use in your classroom.
