## Policy Connections at a Glance

An overview of federal early childhood policies and guidance to inform decision-making and practices in support of positive transitions to kindergarten
for all children and their families. Leaders can refer to this document to ensure that their plans and programs meet national standards for the transition
to kindergarten.
