The chart below contains examples of digital tools for parents, older toddlers, and preschoolers. The digital tools for parents with asterisks\* promote face-to-face interactions between families and their children. They offer parents ways to interact and talk with their child during everyday family routines and activities. The apps and website for older toddlers and preschoolers offer engaging, interactive experiences that support learning in multiple domains. Teachers, family child care providers, and home visitors can share these tools with families or incorporate them into distance learning activities with children and families while programs are closed.
