# **Principles of Child Development**

During the first episode of this series, we introduced three principles of child development. These principles continue to apply. Seen from the child's perspective, they are:

- I am fascinated by people, and I readily learn from them.
- I learn through experience, and I need help getting access to the things that will help me learn and grow.
- I need help navigating change and regulating my emotions.

We will be adding another principle of child development during this episode. It is:

I benefit from doing things for myself when I can.

These principles are true for children of all abilities and at every developmental stage.




These children are eating. What else are they doing? What are some things these children are learning about?
