# **Principles of Child Development**

During the first episode of this series, we introduced three principles of child development. These principles continue to apply, but we adapted them to better fit development during the third year of life. Seen from the child's perspective, they are:

- I am working on becoming social partners with other people, and I readily learn from them.
- I learn through experience.
- I need help navigating change and regulating my emotions.
- I want to do things for myself, but I need you to set limits and still be there to scaffold my behavior.
