Try pressing a little harder with the glue stick and see if that works.

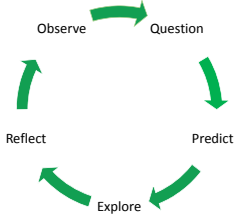


What if we hold the tube at a different angle? Would that help?

Do you think a spoon or a fork would work better for eating rice?

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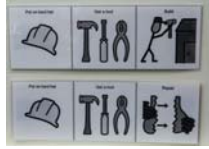
Speak Technology



I noticed you used the scissors to cut the paper into small pieces.



I wonder why this roller made bumps while the other roller made it smooth.



These tools look like they could help solve different types of problems.

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Listen and Model a Questioning Mind



I wonder what we could use to connect your picture to the fence?



I am trying to make this paper towel telescope longer. Any ideas?



What tool worked best to get the glue on your paper plate?

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Teacher Time Minute

How did the teacher support the child's use of technology to make patterns?



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Use scaffolds
Pointed with child as she said the pattern

Provided choice of blocks that might complete the pattern

Support use of the inquiry cycle
Asked, "What color do you think comes next?"

Speak technology
Encouraged child to say colors in the pattern
