Safety Protocols for...

- \circ Participation in and timing of safety training
- \circ Transporting families and transportation safety measures (i.e. use of seat belts, car seats, participation in car seat safety training)
- Maintaining an up to date schedule accessible by the supervisor and coworkers
- \circ Carrying cell phones, identification and other relevant documents to home visits

Protocols for Home Visit Logistics

- Home visitor or family is sick with a transmittable illness or disease
- Inclement weather (i.e. temperatures, snow, ice, hurricane)
- Concerns about neighborhood safety
- Concerns about drugs and/or violence in the home
